SEASONAL WORKER'S COUNCIL

The Seasonal Worker's Council meets every 3rd week to discuss issues concerning seasonal workers. Members of the council are representatives from the seasonal workers, employers and the municipality of Trysil. The Council also sets a calendar of events with various activities throughout the season.

REGISTER TO WORK IN NORWAY

Anyone who comes to Norway to work for the first time is obliged to do a mandatory ID-check at an official tax office (normally at Hamar), to get your mandatory D-number. If you plan to stay in Norway for more than six months, you need to register as a habitant and get a social security code instead of D-number, which also provides you full social and medical rights.
